

PALM TREE Water Main and Force Main Improvements

Construction Update February 8, 2024

Beginning November 28, 2022, contractors for the City of Cape Coral are installing an additional water main and a sanitary sewer force main through a series of residential roadways from Gleason Parkway to the City of Cape Coral's Palm Tree Booster Pump Station located on Palm Tree Boulevard. Benefits of this project include increased water quantity and quality for the surrounding neighborhoods and the southeast quadrant of the City as a whole.

Work is expected to generally occur weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Some night and weekend work may be necessary. This project is expected to be completed in early 2024.

Crews are currently working in the following project areas:

Palm Tree Boulevard and SE 40th Street Lane Closures and One-Lane Flagging for Final Paving Monday, February 12 & Tuesday, February 13, 2024

Beginning 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, 2/12 and Tuesday, 2/13, motorists will experience lane closures and one-lane flagging operations on <u>Palm Tree Boulevard</u> from 3830 Palm Tree Boulevard south to SE 40th Street, <u>SE 40th</u> <u>Street</u> from Palm Tree Boulevard to the canal, and a segment of <u>SE 3rd Avenue</u> just south of SE 40th Street while crews mill and final pave.

- Flaggers will alternate traffic frequently, but motorists should expect delays.
- Local residential traffic will be accommodated, and additional flaggers will be present to assist the residents.
- All lanes will reopen to traffic by 5 p.m. each day.

Crews will continue to restore the road right-of-way (ROW) on the following streets:

- Palm Tree Boulevard
- SE 40th Street
- SE 1st Avenue
- SE 35th Terrace
- Santa Barbara Boulevard
- SW 34th Lane
- SW Santa Barbara Place
- Gleason Parkway

Drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists should use caution and be aware of construction equipment and vehicles entering/exiting streets in the project area.

This schedule may be subject to change due to inclement weather and unforeseen underground conditions.

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
